We seem to have a better idea of what the absence of peace is, than what peace actually is. And, we are all too often overwhelmed by the negative aspects of the world's many problems to appreciate where we are, the progress we have made, and what we need to do to get where we want to be.

Peace is more than the absence of war. It is a dynamic state filled with positive, dynamic creativity and growing capacity. If war is destruction, peace is creation. If war is the limiting of human options and freedoms, peace is the increasing of our options. If war is the trampling of the human spirit, peace is the ennobling and celebration of our spirit and spirituality. On a continuum from war to peace, what is beyond "peace"?

More importantly, what can we do to make our vision of peace on Earth more real? What are the peace related issues about which I feel most strongly?

### **Process:**

This presentation is interactive, engaging and fun. The audience becomes participants in situations that ask them to offer suggestions for solving the world's problems.

No expertise is needed, just one's values, opinions, imagination and creativity.

### **Outcomes:**

Participants become clear on what is important to them, what can be done to make things better, and what they can do about it.
