The **speaker** for this memorable evening will be **John Dear**, an internationally known voice for peace and nonviolence. A longtime activist, popular lecturer, and movement organizer, Fr. John Dear is the author of 35 books and hundreds of articles on non-violence and peace. He was recently nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize by Archbishop Desmond Tutu.
